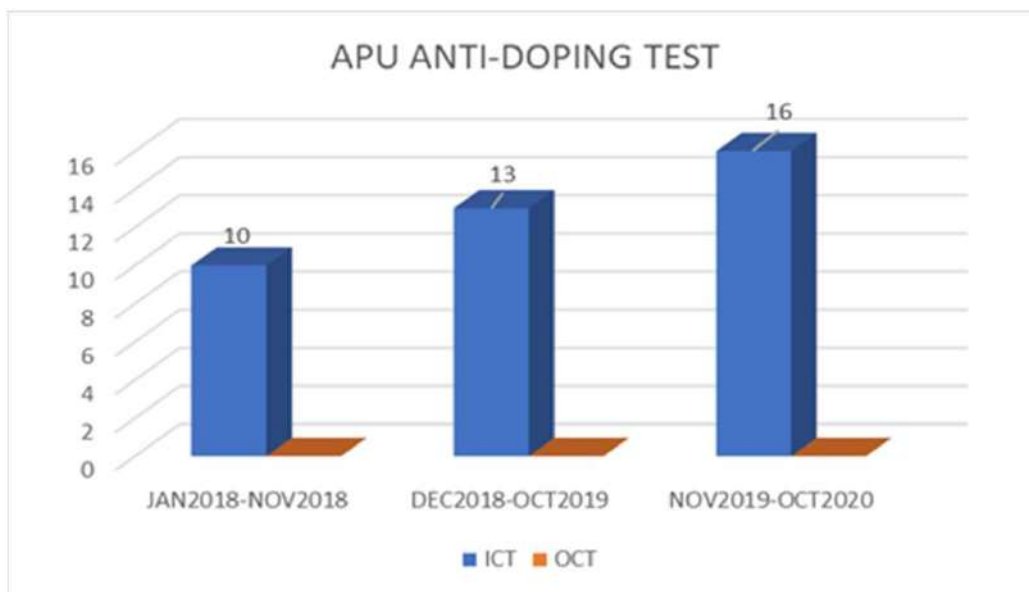

- As per 25 September 2019, The APU Anti-Doping Policy has been approved by the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Authority (ASADA). This Anti-Doping Policy takes effect on 25 September 2019.
- However, entry forms for the 2019 National Classic Powerlifting Championships were already released so 2019 Nationals in November were not eligible for ASADA (SIA) testing, so we utilised PWC instead.
- PWC Global Services GmbH have doping control officers worldwide, and recently domestically.
- Samples are analysed at a WADA-approved lab in Dresden, Germany.
- All associated costs are borne by APU via an invoice from IPF.
- The first Comp tested by SIA in 2020 is APU WA State.
- Total number of competitors during period of testing was **538**.
- **489** raw, **8** equipped and **41** special olympics athletes competed during period of testing.

Anti-Doping Report Cont'd

- **16** anti-doping tests were conducted during period of testing:
 - 2019 APU Australian Classic in NOV, Perth – 8 Test
 - 2019 SE QLD Summer Series in DEC – 3 Test
 - 2020 APU WA State in SEPT – 5 Test
- **0** athletes applied for Therapeutic Use Exemptions:
